

## STARTER INFO - PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 2026

The company COMMUNICO ITALIA SSD a RL with the approval of FIDAL organises the PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 - LG42, a Bronze level race of 42.195 km and the LG21, a Bronze level race of 21.097 km.

Date: 12th April 2026

Start marathon LG42: Limone sul Garda - 9:00 am

Start half marathonLG21: Arco - 9:30 am

Finish: Malcesine

## **Registration opening**

Registration is open until Monday 23th March, 2026, unless it closes early due to reaching the maximum number of participants.

## Start eligibility

Just correctly registered and signed up athletes can participate in the race. Your registration is valid, only when we obtained your full and correct personal data and you paid the registration fees (excluded cases of special authorization by the organizer).

Each runner will receive a bib number at the race package pick-up. To start your race, remember to bring the bib with you to the start. The bib number needs to be worn on the chest.

#### **Participation**

Participation is open to all runners who will reach the age of 18 (LG21) and 20 (LG42) on the date of the event and meet one of the following requirements:

- 1. Runners registered in Italy
  - 1.1. Athletes affiliated to FIDAL or registered with foreign federations affiliated to World Athletics, or
  - 1.2. Athletes in possession of a Runcard (<a href="www.runcard.com">www.runcard.com</a>) or athletes who are members of a Sports Promotion Organization (Sect. Athletics), in possession of a valid Runcard-EPS, limited to persons of at least 18 years of age (LG21) and 20 years of age (LG42) on the date of the event, and in possession of a valid health certificate (valid for athletics).
- 2. Runners from abroad
  - 2.1. Athletes registered with Foreign Federations affiliated to World Athletics,
  - 2.2. Athletes in possession of a valid Runcard (<u>www.runcard.com</u>) or Runcard-EPS, limited to persons of of at least 18 years of age (LG21) and 20 years of





- age (LG42) on the date of the event, and in possession of a valid health certificate (valid for athletics).
- 2.3. Athletes not registered in Italy and without a medical certificate who sign the disclaimer form may participate in the non-competitive race. The list of results will only be announced in alphabetical order and there will be no award ceremony or prize-giving.
- 3. The following are not allowed to take part in the race:
  - 3.1. Registered athletes in possession of a RUNCARD Mountain & Trail;
  - 3.2. Athletes who are members of clubs affiliated with Sports Promotion Bodies recognized by CONI, not affiliated with FIDAL;
  - 3.3. Athletes registered with other Sports Federations (for example: Triathlon, cycling, etc.);
  - 3.4. Athletes with "hand bikes", prams, pushchairs or other wheeled vehicles.

#### **IMPORTANT:**

- ✓ Italian citizens registered at A. I. R. E. are to be considered residents abroad;
- ✓ The medical certificate must be marked 'athletics'. Certificates with the wording 'running', 'running', 'march', 'marathon', 'triathlon', 'half marathon', etc. are not valid for participation;
- ✓ Participants in events may be subject to doping controls. They are also subject to the provisions of Article 25 of the FIDAL Rules, if they are already subject to disciplinary suspension.

## Race package Pick-Up

You can pick up your race package during the following times:

Saturday, April 11 2026

10.00 pm to 07.00 pm Race Package Pick-Up

We recommend picking up the race number and goody bag as soon as possible, since long waiting times and lines could occur on race day. **Please bring your registration confirmation and a valid ID as also:** 

- your medical certificate and the FIDAL card or Runcard (competitive race)
- the liability exclusion form (non-competitive race).

If a discount is applied to your participation fee, please also bring a valid ID and your student card.

Race bibs and race packs may also be collected by third parties, with a written proxy, a letter of confirmation from the delegating party and a photocopy of a valid identity document.

For the LG KIDS the price of one bib has been set to 8€ for the entire registration period. This means that the price will remain the same until registration closes or all the available bibs are sold out.

1. Participation in the PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 is a highly personal right and in principle not transferable. This does not apply to registration changes or a transfer of the starting place to another person. A name change is possible and





free of charge until March 23, 2026. Subsequently no changes can be made.

Distance registration changes are possible under the following conditions:

- 1.1. Each participant can change the distance themselves using the link that they find in the confirmation email received after the registration was completed.
- 1.2. If you change your registration to a route with a lower entry fee than the original registration fee, there is no entitlement to a refund of the difference. A change of registration is free until March 23, 2026 and only if there are still places available for that distance. After that date, or when the limit of participants for that distance is reached, no changes can be made.
- 1.3. If you change your registration to a route with a higher entry fee than the original registration fee, the respective difference is due. A change of registration is free until March 23, 2026 and only if there are still places available for that distance. After that date, or when the limit of participants for that distance is reached, no changes can be made.

## Shuttle/Parking

There are public car parks at the start and finish points (Limone, Arco, Malcesine) which can be used. Please be aware of the road closures!

We also offer a shuttle service to take you to the various locations. In order to secure a place in our shuttles (busses and/or ferries) you need to book it directly at the moment of the registration.

Shuttles can be changed or booked also at a subsequent time but <u>only until</u> March 23, 2026. Subsequently no changes and further booking are possible. To do it, it is necessary to click in the link that you will find in the confirmation email received at the end of the registration process.

The shuttle routes on Sunday, April 12 2026 are as follows:

#### Morning

- Riva Arco (Bus)
- Malcesine Arco (Bus)
- Riva Limone (Ferry)
- Malcesine Limone (Ferry)
- Limone Arco (Ferry + Bus)





#### Afternoon

- Malcesine Arco (Bus)
- Malcesine Limone Riva (Fähre)

In the afternoon, you can also travel free of charge on the ships in regular service on the upper lake (Riva-Torbole-Limone-Malcesine) (not express services). By showing your event bracelet at the ticket office, you will get a free ticket.

## Stops:

Riva (bus): Centro (Piazza Catena)

Malcesine (bus): Autostazione Malcesine (directly at the event site)

Arco (bus): Parcheggio alla Sarca (Via P. Leonardi)

Riva (ferry): Centro (Piazza Catena)

Malcesine (ferry): Centro (Piazza Guglielmo Marconi)

Limone (ferry): Centro (Piazzale Carlo Gerardi)

## Changing rooms & luggage drop-off points

Changing rooms are available on the whole event area. You can drop off your starting bag with personal changing clothes at the start in Limone and in Arco. The bag needs to be labeled with the provided tag. The bag can then be picked up at the finish line in Malcesine. The organizer will not take any responsibility for theft.

# The bags can be handed in up before the start: until 8:45 am (marathon) and 9:00 am (half marathon)

## **Timing**

Every participant needs to wear their own personal race number, since the time measurement chip is attached to it. Thus, race numbers cannot be exchanged and needs to be worn on the chest.

#### WC

Toilets are available on the whole event area and are marked accordingly. There are toilets at all feeding zones along the route (except for feeding zone 1).

## **Start lane**

Only participants wearing a bib number and the event wristband will be allowed into the start lane. Both will be handed out at the Race Package Pick-Up. Please line up in the start lane according to your estimated finish time. The pacemakers and the blocks are an orientation for the times.





Marathon: Block A <3:45 h Block B 3:45 h to 4:10 h Block C >4:10 h

Half marathon: Block A <1:55 h Block B 1:55 h to 2:10 h Block C >2:10 h

#### **Pacers**

To avoid overcharge and ensure that you are reaching the finish line, pacers are available along the course. You recognize the pacers by their flag. They are offered at:

Pacer-times marathon: 3:30 h, 3:45 h, 4:00 h, 4:15 h, 4:30 h, 4:45 h, 5:00 h Pacer-times half marathon: 1:45 h, 2:00 h, 2:15 h, 2:30 h

#### Refreshment stations

Food & beverage stands from local partners are provided in the finish area in Malcesine.

Refreshment points will be set up along the run course, where water, isotonic drinks, fruit as well as bars and gels will be handed out.

#### **Disposal of waste**

Packaging and other waste may only be dropped into the rubbish bins provided on the event areas and at the refreshment points.

## **Award ceremony**

Men and women are ranked separately. Net time is taken into consideration in the result list, while  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$  place are awarded according to gun time.

The first three places in the sporting classification will receive awarded with a voucher and products of our partners.

For athletes taking part in the non-competitive race, a separate results list will be created, which will only be drawn up in alphabetical order, and there will be no awards ceremony or prize-giving.

#### **Time limit**

The race will end at 03.15pm, thus time limit for LG42 is 6.15h and for LG21 is 5.45h. Gun time will be considered.

All participants must have passed the following sections at the appropriate times:

09:10 am: Start Lungolago Limone

10:35 am: Rocca, Riva (10 km)

12:10 pm: Piazza della Canoniche, Arco (21,1 km)

01:15 pm: Strada Statale 249, Piazza Goethe, Torbole (28,3 km)

03:15 pm: Malcesine

#### Withdrawn athletes

A 'broom' vehicle is provided for the recovery of withdrawn athletes at the various feeding zone along the course, which will follow the race and transport the athletes to the finish area.

#### **Health Service**

The Organizing Committee will provide adequate medical assistance on the course and at the start and finish points.

## **Road closures**

Due to route safety, the following roads will be closed on 12.04.2026: SS45bis between Limone and Riva (in both directions) from 8:30 to 10:30 am. The road through Limone is not affected.

SS249 between Torbole and Malcesine/Navene (in both directions) from 9:30 am to 3:00 pm. The road through Malcesine is not affected.

In the communities of Riva and Arco there will be temporary road closures, which can be bypassed.

## **Objection/Complaints**

Any complaints must be submitted in the first instance to the race referee, in the second instance in writing to the appeal jury on April 12, 2026 within 30 minutes of the publication of the results accompanied by a fee of  $\in$  100.00. The fee will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

#### Liability

The organizer is not taking any responsibility for accidents and damages. Every runner needs to make sure they have an appropriate accident insurance. The organizer is covered with personal liability insurance for its own activities.

#### **Final warning**

The organizer reserves the right to modify this information at any time, until April 12, 2026, after having obtained approval from FIDAL. For matters not covered by this Regulation the statutory technical regulations of FIDAL are applicable.
