PEAK LAKE GARDA 42: A FULL WEEKEND OF RUNNING ON LAKE GARDA CONFIRMED AGAIN FOR 2026

The PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 returns from 10 to 12 April 2026, with a weekend dedicated to running along the shores of Lake Garda. As well as the marathon and half marathon, the programme also features a range of side events with something for just about everyone: on Friday, the Oxyburn Trail Run (10 km) in Malcesine; on Saturday, the PEAK Morning Run (8 km) in Limone and the Kids Run in Arco. The Expo Area will be open throughout the weekend, with a plethora of exhibitor stands and product testing opportunities. Registration for the side events opens on Monday 19 January.

As 2026 gets under way, the wait is almost over: just three months to go until the **weekend of pure running** comes to Lake Garda. **From Friday 10 to Sunday 12 April**, the PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 will take centre stage — an event that's far more than just Sunday's marathon and half marathon. As is now practically tradition, the programme is also packed with a series of side events which, starting on Friday 10 April, will turn the weekend into a complete experience for running enthusiasts, newcomers and families alike. Registration for the side events will officially open on **Monday 19 January** on the lakegarda42.com website, but the full event schedule has already been confirmed.

Friday 10 April – Oxyburn Trail Run

The weekend kicks off on Friday 10 April with the Trail Run, which this year welcomes a new Title Sponsor: **Oxyburn**, a brand specialising in technical sports apparel. “As soon as this opportunity came up, we had no hesitation in choosing to partner with PEAK LAKE GARDA 42” commented **Jacopo Pea**, CEO of Oxyburn. “The quality of the organisation, its outstanding natural setting and its focus on sports tourism have established it as a benchmark event in the running world, a market in which our brand is widely recognised for the quality of the garments we offer.”

The race kicks off at 5:00 pm from Piazza Statuto in Malcesine, where the participants will also cross the finish line. Like last year, runners will tackle a 10-kilometre loop around Monte Baldo, with nearly 500 metres of elevation gain. This is a non-competitive community run with no finishing positions. For this reason, the run will conclude with a post-race aperitivo, hosted by the partner Birra Monte Baldo, followed by a get-together with Oxyburn and its ambassadors.

Available places: 250 All participants will receive the **Oxyburn 1216 trail running sock**, specifically designed to ensure maximum breathability and excellent heat dissipation. The GRS polyester sponge footbed also provides excellent impact cushioning.

Saturday 11 April – PEAK Morning Run

The programme continues on Saturday morning with the **PEAK Morning Run** in Limone del Garda, starting at 10:00 am. This non-competitive community run follows an 8-kilometre route that also takes in the spectacular lakeside walkway overlooking Lake Garda.

The Morning Run offers participants the chance to try out some of the models from the **PEAK brand's** running shoe collection, with a particular focus on the brand's patented PEAK TAICHI technology. Available places: 150. All participants will enjoy a hearty breakfast at the finish line and will receive a PEAK T-shirt.

Saturday 11 April – Kids Run

In the afternoon, at 6:00 pm, the focus turns to younger runners with the **Kids Run**, which this year will be staged in a new location: the historic centre of Arco di Trento, just a few kilometres north of Riva del Garda. There will be two courses: 1,000 metres, open to children up to 7 years old (inclusive); 2 km, for participants up to 12 years old (inclusive). All entrants will receive a race pack, finisher's medal and post-race refreshments. Available places: 150. All children registered on or before 24 March will receive a personalised race bib with their name and nationality.

Expo Area

From Friday and throughout the day on Saturday, the **Expo Area** will also be open at Cantiere 26 in Arco. Visitors will be able to browse partner stands, get up close and personal with the products and even test some of them out.

The Expo Area is also where participants should pick up their race packs and bibs, and it will be open as follows: Friday 10 April from 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday 11 April from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm.
