officially opens on 30 July



PEAK LAKE GARDA 42: REGISTRATION FOR THE 2027 EDITION OPENS ON 30 JULY

The sixth edition of the PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 returns to the shores of Lake Garda from 9 to 11 April 2027. Registrations officially open on 30 July, with the first bibs available at a special reduced price. The successful running festival format has been confirmed, with the LG42 marathon and LG21 half marathon taking place on Sunday 11 April, while Friday and Saturday will feature a packed programme of side activities for runners, families and supporters. A unique race spanning three different regions, with two start locations and one shared finish line.

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Spring will once again bring a sporting buzz to the shores of Lake Garda as the **PEAK LAKE GARDA 42** returns. Over the past six years, the event has attracted runners from Italy and beyond with a unique format combining competition, spectacular scenery and the chance to discover the area.

Following the success of previous editions, the event will return in 2027 with an entire weekend dedicated to running and the wide running community. The programme of side activities gets underway on Friday **9 April**, offering something not only for registered runners but also for families and any other accompanying guest. The weekend will reach its climax on **Sunday 11 April** with the two main races: the **LG42 marathon** and the **LG21 half marathon**.

The unique format that has become the event's hallmark over the years is also confirmed for 2027: the marathon starts in **Limone sul Garda** (in the province of Brescia), the half marathon in **Arco** (in the province of Trento), and both races finish in **Malcesine** (in the province of Verona), with runners following a spectacular route through a landscape of mountains and the waters of Lake Garda.

"The PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 continues to grow because it has developed a strong identity that goes far beyond the race itself," comments **Jan Bruns**, Event Manager at **COMMUNICO ITALIA SSD A RL**. *"Our aim is to offer a complete experience every year,*

combining organisational excellence with the opportunity to showcase a unique area. For runners, this means enjoying a high-quality race as well as a weekend to remember."



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For the 2027 edition, the progressive registration fee structure based on the number of available race bibs will once again be used. The first registration tier will be offered at a reduced rate and, once sold out, registrations will automatically move to the next pricing level. The first **300 race bibs** will be available at the Early Bird price of **€73.00** for the LG42 and **€63.00** for the LG21.

The registration fee includes all services provided for participants, including pre- and post-race shuttle transfers between the event locations, with buses and ferries available to all registered runners.

To ensure that the high standards of service established in previous editions are maintained, the organisers have once again **set an overall limit of 5,000 participants** across the two races on Sunday. As in previous years, places are expected to sell out quickly. Runners keen to take part in the 2027 PEAK LAKE GARDA 42 are therefore advised to secure their place as early as possible.

Registration for the LG KIDS race, taking place on Saturday afternoon, costs **€8.00**, with the fee remaining unchanged until registration closes or all available places have been taken.
